

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Student tuition and payment terms

The total amount of the gratuity of the program SWitCH is 2 850,00 euros. Payment of this amount must be made in full before the start date of the course, in order to complete the enrollment of the selected students.

Evaluation and access to internship

Only after approval of **all** the curricular units in the academic phase, students will be able to join one of the associated companies of Porto Tech Hub for the internship phase.

In the case of students who do not reach positive grades in **all** subjects in the academic phase of the program, they will be able to repeat in full this same academic phase, for the payment of a student fee of 2 850,00 euros.

The course works in a project-based learning (PBL) approach and with continuous assessment of competencies throughout the semester. Nonetheless, ISEP provides a time of recourse with adequate evidence to the specific characteristics of each course unit, giving the students one last opportunity to demonstrate that they have acquired the minimum skills to be approved at each subject. Each of these tests does not replace the entire evaluation during the semester of the course unit.

Location of classes and faculty members

The entire teaching phase of the course (9 months) is taught in the facilities of Instituto Superior de Engenharia do Porto (ISEP), in classrooms dedicated exclusively to SWitCH. The faculty consists of members of this Institute.

- Accesses in ISEP

SWitCH's students are ISEP's students and will have access to facilities and services (canteen, car park and others) under the same conditions as other students enrolled in the Institute.

Materials available

ISEP and Porto Tech Hub provide all necessary bibliography as well as study materials. Students should, however, have their own laptop, so as to facilitate teamwork on a daily basis in (the minimum requirements are Intel i5 or equivalent processor, 8 GB RAM, 256 GB disk).

Photographic and video materials

In certain situations (classroom environment, presentations, among others), Porto Tech Hub makes photographic and/ or video records that can be used to help promote the program and its associated companies and institutions. When you apply for the course, you are confirming
